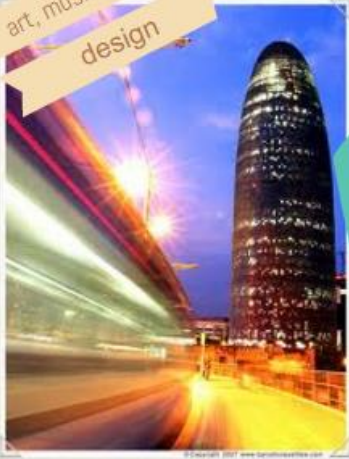

Modernisme wanted to break with the ways of the past and create new art. It was an eclectic movement, which had an important effect on architecture. Modernist architecture represents a renewal of shapes inspired by nature, the use of new materials and a nationalistic sentiment. In Catalonia, the Catalan Art Nouveau takes on its own personality differentiated from the rest of Europe, with the geniuses of Lluís Domènech i Montaner, Antoni Gaudí and Josep Puig i Cadafalch. This cultural movement was filled with all the arts and sought to recover Catalan culture and modernise the country.

# THE GALLERY HOTEL

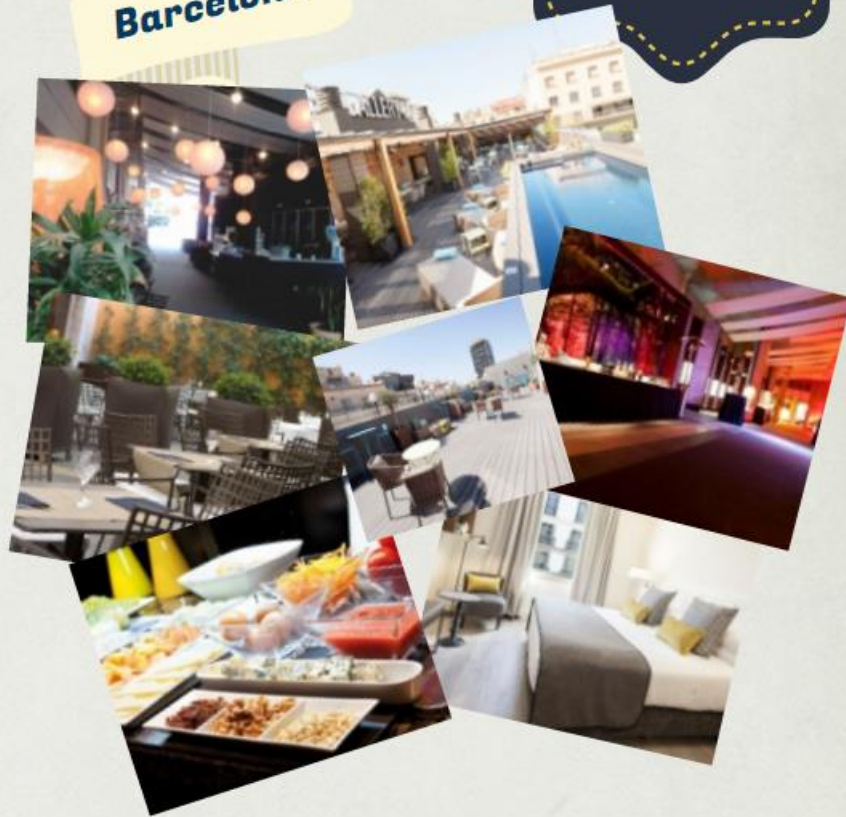

# LA PEDRERA

Casa Milà, popularly known as 'La Pedrera', is probably one of the most famous buildings of the Catalan Modernisme or Catalan Art Nouveau period and one of the architect Antoni Gaudí's most ambitious works. It is a container that is a work of art in itself.



Although its official denomination is Casa Milà because it was a building initiative of that family,

who also took up residence there, it was soon given the nickname

'LA PEDRERA'

which alludes ironically, as we have said, to the appearance of the exterior, reminiscent of an open quarry.

Its singularity and artistic and heritage value are amply accredited by its inclusion in the city of Barcelona Artistic Heritage catalogue in 1962; by its declaration as Historical and Artistic Monument of National Interest by the Spanish government in 1969; or by its entry by UNESCO on its World Heritage list in 1984, for its exceptional universal value.
